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Event Info

The Lionfish Removal and Awareness Day festival will be open to the public from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturday, May 20 & Sunday, May 21. The festival and tournament will take place at the Plaza de Luna Park, 900 S. Palafox St., Pensacola. Set Up & Breakdown

Vendor set up is Friday, May 19 from 1p.m to 6 p.m and Saturday, May 20 from 7:00 - 9:30 a.m. Breakdown is Sunday afternoon at 5 p.m. There will be barricades blocking off the round-about Friday through Sunday. We will allow vendor vehicles into the park during designated set-up times **ONLY**. Due to the limited space in the park, we ask that you quickly unload all materials from your vehicle and then move your vehicle to parking before completing booth set up. More information on set-up and vendor assignments will be sent at a later date.

Parking

Since we'll be set up before the crowds arrive, there will likely be room in public parking lot 16 (see link below) between Palafox & Jefferson. There will be accessible parking available at the South end of this lot as well. There are no parking passes or fees required. <http://ReefRangers.com/Event-Info/Parking/>

Security

There will be overnight security from the Pensacola Police Department at the park both Friday night and Saturday night. We ask that you please breakdown your booth Sunday afternoon since there will not be security on Sunday evening.

Equipment

Unless indicated on your application, please bring your own tent and tables. Please be prepared to bring your own chairs and any extension cords or other tools you may need. Keep in mind that the event is being held at the end of a pier and we could be affected by strong winds. Be prepared and bring equipment to weigh down your tents and other materials. Each space is only 10'x10' unless you have discussed otherwise with the event organizer.

Disruptive Activities

Vendor shall not engage in any activity that is disruptive. Vendors engaged in disruptive activities will be subject to removal and/or forfeiture of any payment.

Release of Liability

Vendor hereby agrees to release, waive and discharge Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, Fish and Wildlife Foundation of Florida and their employees, sponsors, volunteers and agents from all losses, damages, claims, costs, expenses and liabilities, including attorney fees, for injury to person or property arising in connection with my participation in Lionfish Awareness and Removal Day activities and use of the facilities and equipment.
